



# Brightside Cleanliness Assessment Cleanliness Assessment App (iPhone/iPad)



Through a grant awarded by Keep America Beautiful and Waste Management, Brightside has worked with developers from Triadic, LLC to create an application for iPhone, iPad, and eventually, Android devices. This tool is meant to take the place of our current paper score card used by the Assessment Teams and streamline both the reporting and data collection process and be more mindful of our sustainability goals.



Home Screen




Council District  
Selection Screen




Specific Assessment  
Site Selection Screen



– Screen 1



# Brightside Green Living Neighborhood Certification Program



Improving the overall good health of our community members is one of Mayor Fischer's key priorities ~ programs like the Green Living Neighborhood Certification, coordinated by Brightside and developed in partnership with the Office of Sustainability, recognizes our neighbors who have made conscious choices to live more sustainable and healthy lifestyles.

# Brightside Green Living Neighborhood Certification Program

**12 Neighborhoods** have registered and are working towards certification representing more than **425 households** throughout our community.

- ~ Our first Green Certified Neighborhood is located within the Shawnee Neighborhood and had just under 50 households participate.
- ~ Other Neighborhood Areas Represented: Highlands/ Douglas, Seneca Gardens, Americana Neighborhood (Southern Pkwy), Germantown, Middletown, Jeffersontown

We are still recruiting Neighborhoods and Green Captains within the communities to facilitate the program in their neighborhoods. This captain will serve as the contact person for their neighborhood's participation and are vital to the success of the program.
