(liquid cooling options create "forever chemical" problems - during maintenance or with minor leaks, these non-degradable chemicals risk escaping into soil and groundwater) 2) The 40 - 65 decibel low-frequency hum from system fans create noise pollution and ground vibrations: this: a) elevates stress hormones in humans and animals, directly disrupting sleep, reproductive cycles and breeding. b) drives away critical seed dispersing birds (reducing forest seedlings up to 75%) c) forces indigenous wildlife away. c) paired with the security lighting, disrupts the sleep cycles of nocturnal animals (bats &amp; owls) and triggers chronic insomnia in humans (a list of health complications are directly related to lack of sleep). 3) Diesel generators release nitrogen oxides and fine particulate matter which aggravates airways spiking asthma, respiratory hospitalizations and premature deaths. (Acoustic dampening cannot block low frequency infrasound noise and vibrations). 4) ANY size center increase global warming. All of these will negatively affect Kentucky's current bourbon and horse industry AND all Kentuckians. None of the proposed adjustments will fix these issues: Acoustic walls cannot block low frequency noise nor the vibrations, planting trees will take 15 - 20 years to provide any acoustic dampening or air filtration, liquid cooling (risks noted above) Note: the comment made in the prior Metro Council Meeting was confusing: Not once have any of the currently existing 4,000+ currently operating centers created excess electricity saving residents money. In every other state, utility costs have increased, with the largest increase being a 16% year over year increase in Illinois (13% in Virginia, 12% in Ohio).
