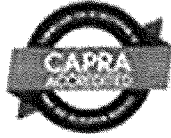

Subject: Kayak Launch at McNeely Lake

Good Morning Councilman,

Here is an example of the kind of structure we are considering. Next steps are for our engineers to make a site visit and look into the best location for this type of structure. It functions as a very user friendly launch that secures the kayak while users load into it. The addition of the overhead hand holds and retractable seat also allow it to be handicap accessible, making it easier for those in a wheelchair to scoot down the steps and use the handholds to help lower themselves onto the kayak. As I mentioned, this is a pilot project and we really want to find the ideal set-up on the lake and evaluate how much usage it gets.
