Kenwood Road New Sidewalk Estimate

CW George / Rachael,

Please find below my estimate for a new concrete sidewalk on the "south side" of Kenwood Drive from Orchard Hill Drive to the firehouse entrance next to Alpine Way. The total cost under the latest TARC contract would be \$100,000. This includes for a professional survey to establish the existing right of way along the project limits, tree removal by Bob Ray company (thru the Metro Annual contract), tree replacement by Podges Landscaping. TARC has agreed to 50% - 50% partnership with Metro District 21. Metro Public Works will supply the design plans and the proposed construction work will be done under the TARC contract.

Kenwood Sidewalk Constituent Feedback

- "I am most sadden by losing trees. I would vote for minimum tree loss. Very interested in the lighting.
- "With a crosswalk"
- "Improved lighting on both sides"
- "DeSales crosswalk a must"
- "Put in crosswalks first"
- "If we have crosswalks"

Other: 7 responses

- "You can do better" ???
- "Everyone already uses the "trolley" road for walking on a multiuse path. It makes more sense to continue with using what people are used to. Crosswalks are needed regardless.
- "Continue with access road is preferred"
- "Continue with access road is preferred"
- "Make the local access road on the north side the multi-use path and extend it from the bank property to the end of the road in front of DeSales or extend around the corner and down the west side of 3rd St. to Seneca Trail. This provides safe access for walkers, bike riders, (by blocking through access similar to Southern Pkwy 4500 block you can provide safety for walkers, bicyclists, TARC riders, car parked. This would be more cost effective and provide all the needs that you are seeking. If the TARC routes don't work with the proposal then reverse the route, same service and less cost. Cross walks would not be needed."
