I have revised the Frankfort Ave. cost based on our pre-construction meeting. Due to the complexity of some stop improvements, I have needed to increase the project budget from \$19,124 to \$26,300.

The corresponding 20% would therefore increase from \$3,822 to \$5,260. I know this increase may be an issue, so please let me know if you have matching funds still available to make this adjustment.
