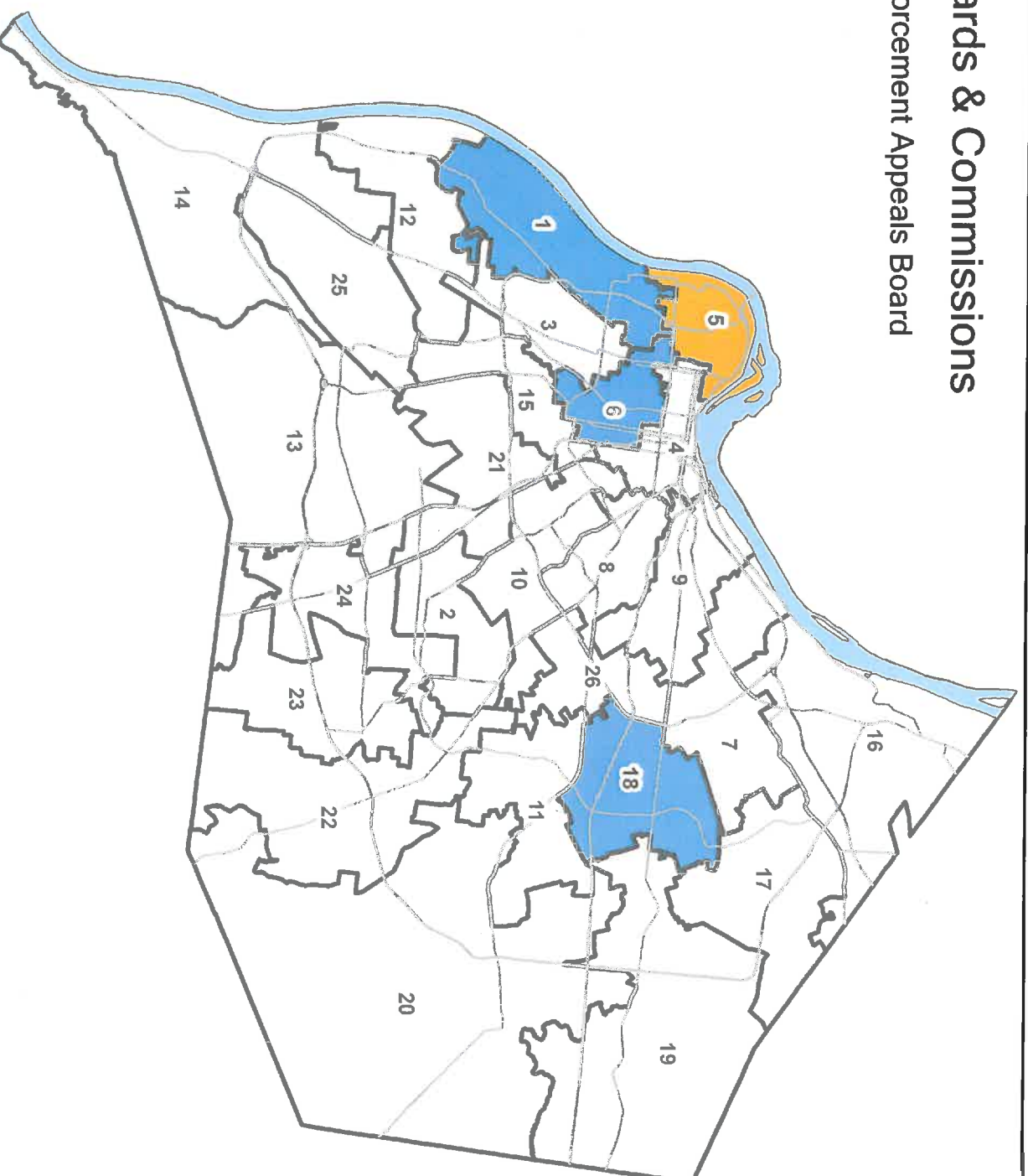

STATUTORY AUTHORITY	KRS 65.8801 through 65.8839
ORDINANCE AUTHORITY	LMCO 32.275 et seq.
NUMBER OF MEMBERS	3, with 2 alternates that meet same qualifications as members
HOW APPOINTED	By mayor with approval of council, within 60 days of vacancy.
EX OFFICIO MEMBERS	None
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	- Residents of Metro Government for one year before and during appointment term. - May not hold any elected or non-elected office, paid or non-paid, or any position of employment with the Metro Government.
COUNCIL APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT	Yes
COMPENSATION	May be reimbursed for actual expenses. May be compensated no greater than \$100 per meeting.
TERM OF APPOINTMENT	3 years
VACANCY APPOINTMENT	Any vacancy on the board shall be filled by the Mayor, subject to approval of the Council within 60 days of vacancy. If the vacancy is not filled within that time period, the remaining Code Enforcement Board members shall fill the vacancy. All vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term.

AUTOMATIC REAPPOINTMENT UNDER KRS 65.008(2)?	No
REMOVAL	A code board member may be removed from office by the Mayor for misconduct, inefficiency, or willful neglect of duty. The Mayor must submit a written statement to the member and the Council setting forth the reasons for removal.
POWERS	To issue remedial orders and impose civil fines as a method of enforcing ordinance when a violation of the ordinance is a civil offense. Cannot enforce any ordinance which constitutes a criminal offense under state law or any moving motor vehicle offense. Adopt rules and regulations to govern its operation and conduct of its hearings. Any member of the Board may be assigned to conduct hearings. Schedule hearings within 30 days of request for hearing. Send notice of hearings to violators not less than 7 days in advance. Conduct hearings, or assign a hearing officer to conduct a hearing, to determine if violation of ordinance. Subpoena alleged violators, witnesses and evidence to hearings. Take testimony under oath. Make findings of fact and issue orders. Impose civil fines on violators. Impose enforcement costs against violators. To hear appeals from booking fees imposed by Metro Government pursuant to KRS 441.265. No subpoena power and no administrative costs can be charged on these events.
BONDING AUTHORITY	No
RECORDS/REPORTS	Minutes shall be kept for all proceedings of the Board and the vote of each member on any issue shall be recorded in the

	minutes. All testimony taken under oath shall be recorded.
PURPOSE	The Code Enforcement Board shall have jurisdiction to enforce and shall enforce those city ordinances and code provisions, which specifically provide for code board enforcement or which contain provisions for the imposition of civil penalties.
MEETING	No less than once a month and as many times a month as may be necessary to conduct the business of the board.
