At this end of the project, we are going to need to acquire a Perm. Sidewalk Easement in front of 6107 Ashby Lane (Grace Crossing Church). Would your office like to reach out to them for a "donated" easement? This could save the project (and taxpayers) a little bit of money here. I have often heard that churches are the worst to deal with, but we recently had a church in D10 donate a sidewalk easement to Metro.
