TERM LIMIT

The Human Relations Commission-Advocacy shall cooperate with federal, state, and other local agencies in efforts to develop harmonious intergroup and interracial relations, and shall endeavor to enlist the support of civic, religious, labor, industrial, and commercial groups, and civic leaders dedicated to the improvement of human relations and elimination of discriminatory practices.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY KRS Ch. 344

ORDINANCE AUTHORITY¹ LMCO 32.761

POWERS Act as conciliator in controversies involving intergroup and interracial relations.

REMOVAL Members are subject to removal by the Mayor at the discretion of the Mayor.

**QUALIFICATION OF
MEMBERS**

Members shall reside in Jefferson County and no more than one member shall reside within any council district. The members so appointed shall include persons who are representative of the several social, economic, cultural, ethnic, and racial groups that comprise the population of Metro Louisville.
