German-Paristown & Schnitzelburg Street Name Signs

German-Paristown Logo:

- 1 – 9” Goss Ave 900 – the existing Logan Street sign will remain as is.
- 1 – 9” Boyle St. 1200 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 900 – installers will relocate new signs at utility pole in front of 933 Goss Ave.
- 1 – 9” Krieger St. 1200 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 900
- 1 – 9” Spratt St. 1200 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 1200 – installers remove existing post and relocate new signs at utility pole at Four Pegs Beer Lounge.
- 1 – 12” Texas Ave. 1200 & 1 – 12” Goss Ave. 1200 – both will be installed on utility pole in front of 1201 Goss Ave.
- 1 – 12” Goss Ave. 1200 at Eastern Pkwy 1100. Existing Eastern Pkwy sign will remain as is.

Schnitzelburg Logo:

- 1 – 12” Goss Ave 1200 at Eastern Pkwy 1000. Faded 12” Eastern Pkwy 1000 sign will be replaced with standard green street name sign (no charge).
- 1 – 9” Reasor Ave. 1000 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 1200. Both signs are to be installed above new Stop sign (replace faded – no charge) & new 10’ post.

- 1 – 12” Texas Ave. 1300 & 1 – 12” Goss Ave. 1000. Both to be installed on utility pole in front of 1138 Goss Ave. / old barbershop.
- 1—9” Hickory St. 1300 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 1000. Both to be installed in front of 1036 Goss Ave.
- 1 – 9” George Hauck Way 1300, 1 – 9” ←To Hoertz Ave. 1300 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 900. This installation will require a new Tap In base and 10’ Post. George Hauck Way 1300 must be installed ABOVE ← To Hoertz Way 1300.
- 1 – 9” McHenry St. 1300 & 1 – 9” Goss Ave. 900. Both to be installed in front of 948 Goss Ave.
