**Subject:** District 7 Rudy Ln street lights

For the Rudy Ln street light project, the plan is to install 5 Colonial Style LED lights along the Rudy Ln frontage of 2501 Rudy Ln. The cost for the 5-Year lease of the street lights will be \$6,840 plus a one-time installation cost of \$1,250. There is a possibility that an easement will be required for the installation of the lights and the estimated cost is \$2,500. To move this project forward, Public Works will accept \$10,590 for the LGE leased lights from District 7 NDF. Additional funds may be necessary depending on the final costs of the acquisition.

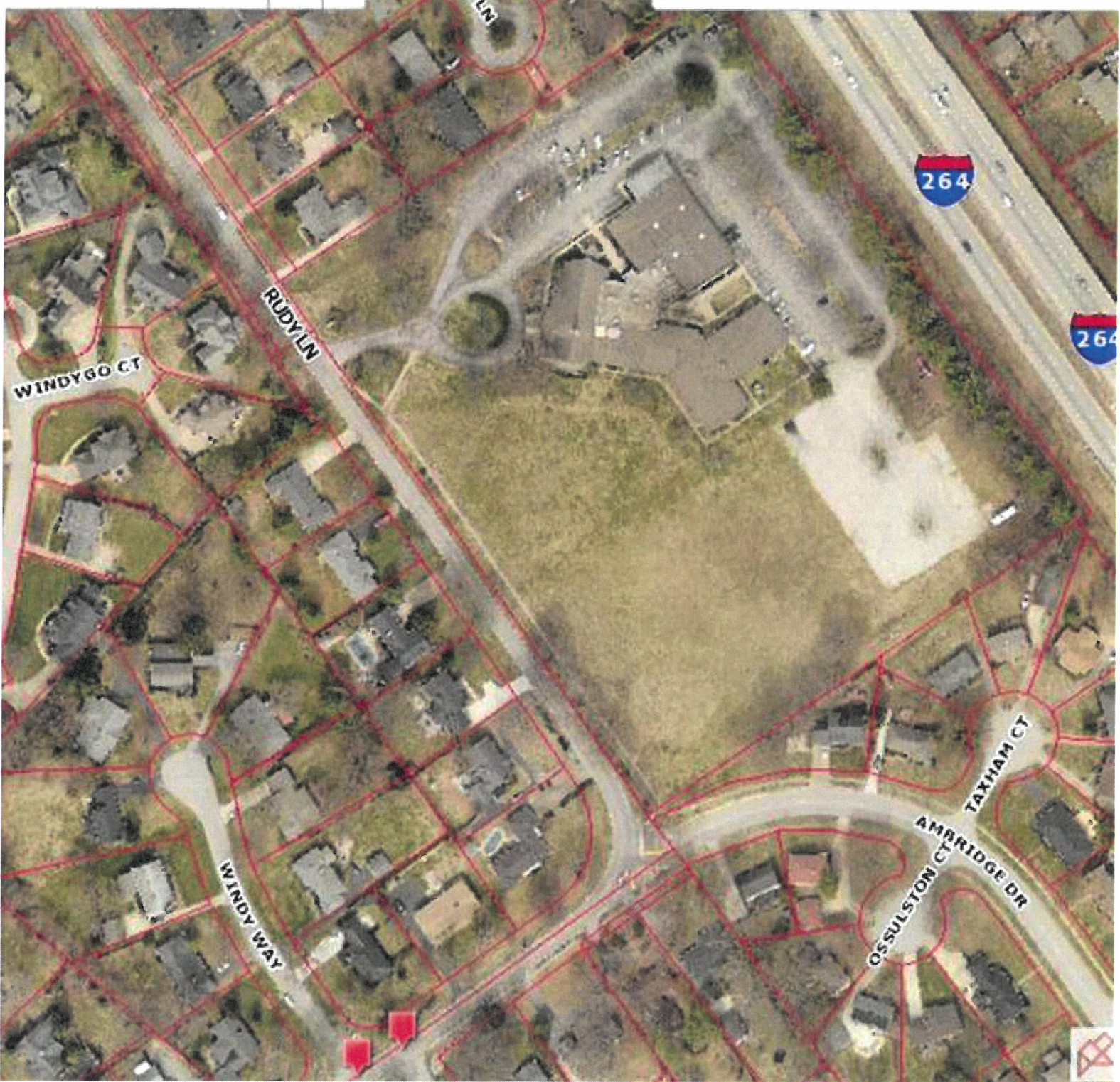
LGE will need to install the streetlights in the public right-of-way or get an easement from the church for permission to install on their private property. I use the LOJIC mapping as a tool to research right-of-way but it is rarely 100% accurate. The red lines in the photo below are the property lines and you can see that the existing sidewalk along the church looks like it is on the church property and not in the public right-of-way, which is weird, but should be something that LGE can address if we move forward with the installation. Just giving you a heads up that it may require a conversation with the church at some point.
