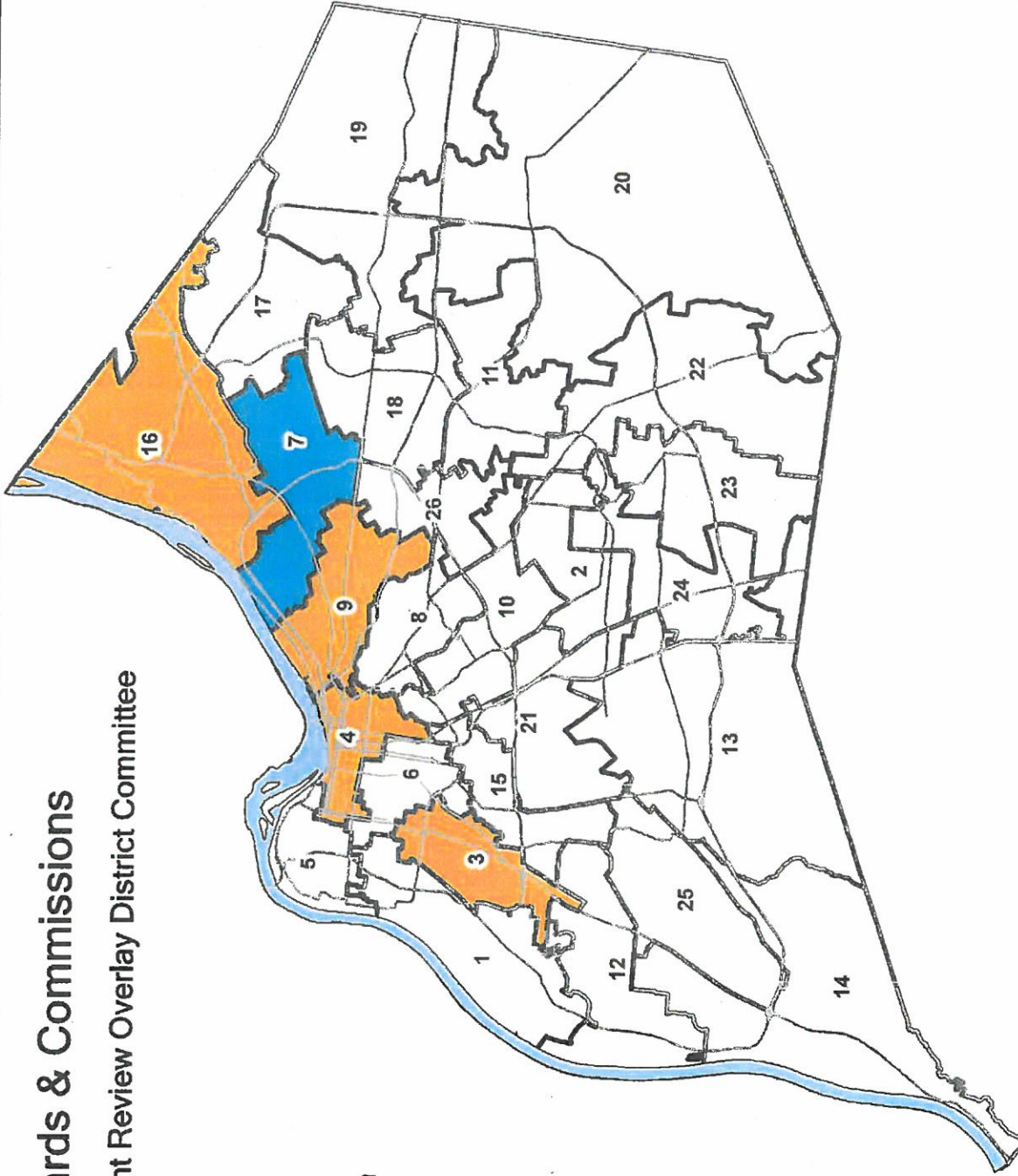

POWERS

(1) Meet with applicants for non-expedited development projects to review their applications; and
 (2) Prepare, pursuant to the procedures set forth in LMCO Chapter 162, final findings of fact and conclusion on non-expedited development applications to issue an overlay district permit, issue the permit with conditions, or deny the permit; and
 (3) Review decisions of the Urban Design Administrator on expedited development applications upon request of the applicant pursuant to LMCO Chapter 162; and
 (4) Recommend to the Council amendments to the Guidelines as provided in LMCO Chapter 162.

REMOVAL Mayoral appointments serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

**TERM OF APPOINTMENT
DETAILS**

3 years or until successor appointed.
The Chair shall serve for a one-year term and shall be eligible for re-election.

**VACANCY APPOINTMENT
DETAILS**

Any vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original.

QUORUM

A quorum of the Committee shall be a majority of the members of the Committee.
The concurring vote of a majority of the members present shall be necessary to take action on a Permit application.

HOW APPOINTED

8 members are appointed by the Mayor with Council approval:
1 architect
1 architect or landscape architect
1 member of Mayor's Committee on Public Amenities
5 members who shall be downtown property owners, downtown business persons or downtown residents, provided that at least one of whom shall be a representative of the Board of the Downtown Development Corporation, and at least one shall be a downtown resident.

**QUALIFICATION OF
MEMBERS**

All members appointed by the Mayor must be residents of Jefferson County or owners of properties or businesses in downtown.

PURPOSE

To review all non-expedited applications for development activity in District and recommend whether the proposed development complies with Overlay District guidelines; promote compatibility between new development and existing land use; enhance visual quality; preserve commercial character with pedestrian friendly environment; strengthen new investment; and provide public review of design of proposed development.
