Ms. Cox,

It is good to hear from you again, I hope this day finds you well! To give you a better understanding of the street closure request, I have attached copies of both the Development Plan and Street Closure Plat for your reference. The request is to close only a portion of Rosemont Avenue, namely, the portion between the Meredith Dunn properties and also between Meredith Dunn and the Arby's down towards Midland Avenue. The access from your property to Rosemont Avenue will remain as is and the area of the closure has actually been shortened by 1.76 feet from the southeast corner of your property. The plat shows this 1.76 foot measurement and the development plan shows where your access drive is in relation to the area of the closure. Since the applicant decided to pull back the area of closure, your property no longer is an abutting property. Though this technically means that you do not have to be notified of when this case will be heard before the Land Development and Transportation Committee (LD&T), since you specifically requested to be notified, you will be sent a notice at the address you listed below. The meeting date has not yet been determined.

The case will be heard by LD&T which will place the case on the agenda for the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission will then make a recommendation to the Louisville Metro Council which will have the final authority to approve or deny the street closure.

My husband and I currently own 9000 square feet of office space at 3834 Taylorsville Rd, 40220. Our property has two entrances one on Taylorsville Road and the other on Rosemont Avenue. We have nine operating business owners renting space.

On July 21 I saw a zoning notice posted in front of the school. That afternoon I made an inquiry to Spencer in your office, he was extremely helpful and prompt. He was able to send me the proposed request from Merideth Dunn. After two or three conversations he believed David Wagner may be able to help me further. He too was prompt to respond and referred me to Latondra Yates. She returned my call right away and was informative and professional. Ms. Yates realized my concerns were only with a consideration of a closure or partial closure of Rosemont Avenue. Ms. Yates thought I should address this again with David Wagner.
