Christa,

I ran an estimate for you on the alley parallel to 1st and 2nd street running from Chestnut to Muhammed Ali and came up with a number of \$25,000.00. From Muhammed Ali heading south approximately 200 feet is concrete that does not appear to be in terrible condition, so I would not touch this section of the alley. From there it transitions to asphalt and runs the remainder of the way to Chestnut. At the location of this transition I suspect that we will need to perform more extensive work so my estimate is a little high just in case I am correct on my assumption. I am also recommending that we remove 2.5 inches of asphalt and replace with the same as there are a significant amount of pot holes and utility cuts in the area.
