Andrew,

Do you know the rating for Bethany? It looks like it needs it. In my previous email I mentioned the entrance way to Sun Valley Estates being included hopefully at a reduced cost due to staging costs already in the estimate for Bethany. Is this the case?

Also, what does the "paperwork" consist of other than a letter to that affect? Could you give me an updated estimate including Blaze Way?

I also wondered about the CDBG project in Valley Village on Tennis Blvd. It is my understanding the roadway has to be torn out to base and replaced as a requirement for funding. I have \$150K for that project and wondered how much roadway that will cover if replacement is a requirement. This is one of the many problematic streets in VV that stands in water due to the problems we have discussed previously. I anticipate this funding to be available annually and want to make sure we are able to remedy the worse streets.
