AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$9,500~~ ~~\$11,500~~ \$15,500 FROM DISTRICT NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$4,500 FROM DISTRICT 12; \$1,500 FROM DISTRICT 14; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 15, 3, 9, 24, 13, 25; \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 16, 2, 6, 10, 17, 20, 21; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO HARBOR HOUSE OF LOUISVILLE, INC., FOR PROGRAM EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE KEN-DUCKY DERBY (As Amended).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$9,500~~ ~~\$11,500~~ \$15,500 is hereby appropriated from the balance of District Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$4,500 from District 12; \$1,500 from District 14; \$1,000 each from Districts 15, 3, 9, 24, 13, 25; \$500 each from Districts 16, 2, 6, 10, 17, 20, 21; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Harbor House of Louisville, Inc., for program expenses associated with the Ken-Ducky Derby.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.


