It is incredibly helpful to have first-hand conversations such as the one you brought to St. Matthews Baptist Church. The neighbors I was most hoping to be present--Janet and Tom Raderer--were out of town, so I did my best to listen some more to their concerns, and be a good citizen with them. They are maintaining a wait-and-see attitude, which of course is reasonable.

Reflectors

As for reflectors for the jutting curbs in the vicinity, when all parking spaces are filled there seems to be little hazard, but when empty or only sparsely filled, a jutting curb can come as a nasty surprise:

1. Wallace Center

On Wallace Street, both sides of the street from Lexington Road to Wilmington Avenue

2. Meridian Avenue at Willis Avenue

Southeast corner of intersection by stop sign (next to church)

3. Breckenridge Lane at Willis Avenue

Northeast corner next to Porter Paint (again, no problem if occupied)

4. Fairfax Avenue between Shelbyville Road and Dayton Avenue

East side of street, two jutting curbs

As soon as I send this, I'm sure another one will jump out in front of me, but these are the ones I have identified to this point. I regret that I didn't get this done right after we spoke. You were very kindly attentive to my concern.

Again, thanks for your presentation, and for helping make our fair city an outstanding place to live!
