Two (2) Speed Humps x \$2,950.00 = \$5,900.00
Two (2) Speed Hump signs x \$200.00 = \$400.00
Total = \$6,300.00

Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,950.00 and each sign is \$200.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of two (2) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for S. Shawnee Terrace, between W. Market Street and Duncan Street. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$6,300.00, and as I understand it, you have offered to fund the entire amount.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as schedule and weather permits.

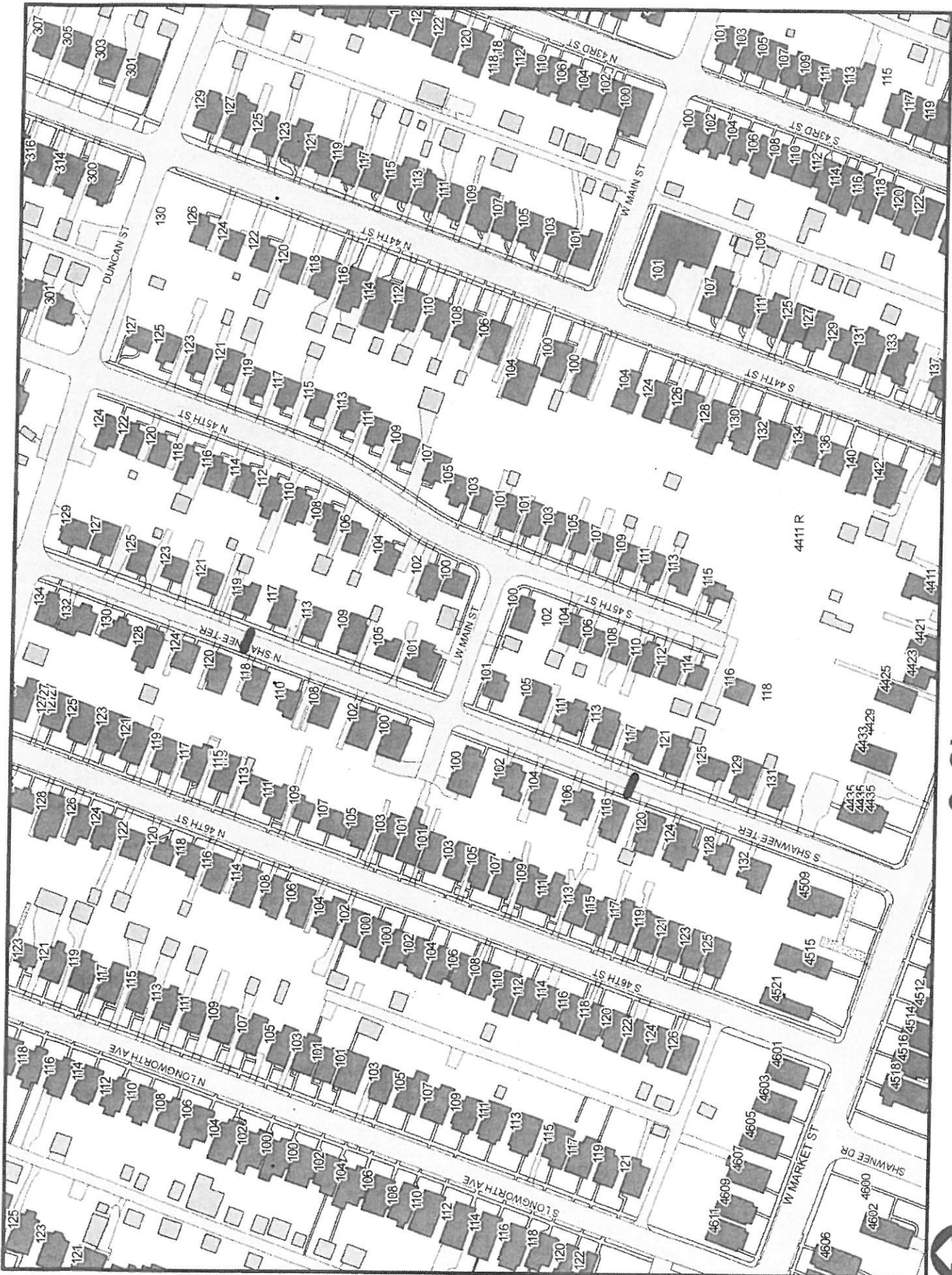
