Jeff & Matthew,

I know these are a lot of roads, but I believe David intends to complete as many as possible in the Prairie Village area as possible with leftover CIF dollars. After speaking with David we are requesting estimates for the following roads:

1. Nordic Drive **From Stonestreet Rd to Holiday Dr \$78,000.00**
2. Highcrest Avenue **from Nordic Dr to dead end \$50,000.00 (from Holiday to Nordic appears to have been paved previously)**
- ★ 3. Vega Lane **from Holiday Dr to the dead end \$62,500.00**

These two Streets were not paved by the State a few years back when 3rd Street Road was paved. We were told the state would not pave these access streets and that they were Louisville Metro Responsibilities.

I see on Lojic that information has been updated and it is Metro's responsibility.

4. 3rd Street Road Access Road – 9601 – 9619 **\$15,000.00**
- ★ 5. 3rd Street Road Access Road – 9711 – 9731 **\$20,000.00**
- ★ 6. Gaywood Drive **From Stonestrret Rd to Nanka Rd \$45,000.00**
7. Nanka Road **from dead end to Iron Horse Way \$150,000.00**
8. Moonlight Way **from Valley Station Rd to Heavenly Way \$80,000.00**
9. Starlight Way **from Moonlight Way to Moonlight Way \$85,000.00**
- ★ 10. Crestridge Drive **from Gaywood Dr to Nanka Rd \$35,000.00**
- ★ 11. Prairie Drive **from Stonestreet Rd to Nanka Rd \$72,000.00**

12. Marseille Drive **from Stonestreet Rd to dead end \$32,000.00**
13. Jasper Drive **from Marseille Dr to dead end \$12,000.00**
14. Jasper Court **from Jasper Dr to dead end \$7,500.00**

15. Bridgagate Court **from Holiday Dr to dead end \$25,000.00**

16. Fordhaven Road **from St Anthony Church Rd to dead end \$110,000.00**
17. Springfield Drive **from St Anthony Church Rd to St Anthony Gardens Dr \$70,000.00**
18. Mitchell Lane **from 3rd Street Rd to dead end (note: includes Docks Ln as well) \$100,000.00**
