POWERS

Vested with all the authority and privileges, exercise all the franchises, and have possession, control and management of all properties of the corporation of which the Metro Government owns all stock; make contracts; sue and be sued; fix and collect reasonable rates for the use of water furnished; may be authorized to fix reasonable conditions upon which board of waterworks may cut into the public ways; may borrow money; may issue bonds; may establish and enforce reasonable rules and regulations.

Secretary and Treasurer may be elected by Board, or combined into one person.

County residents; no more than 3 of same political party; owners of real estate in County. All must be at least 30 years of age. No officers or employees of the City can be appointed to board. Must own real estate in Jefferson County.

President, treasurer, secretary and chief engineer serve for one year term or until their successors have been elected and qualified.

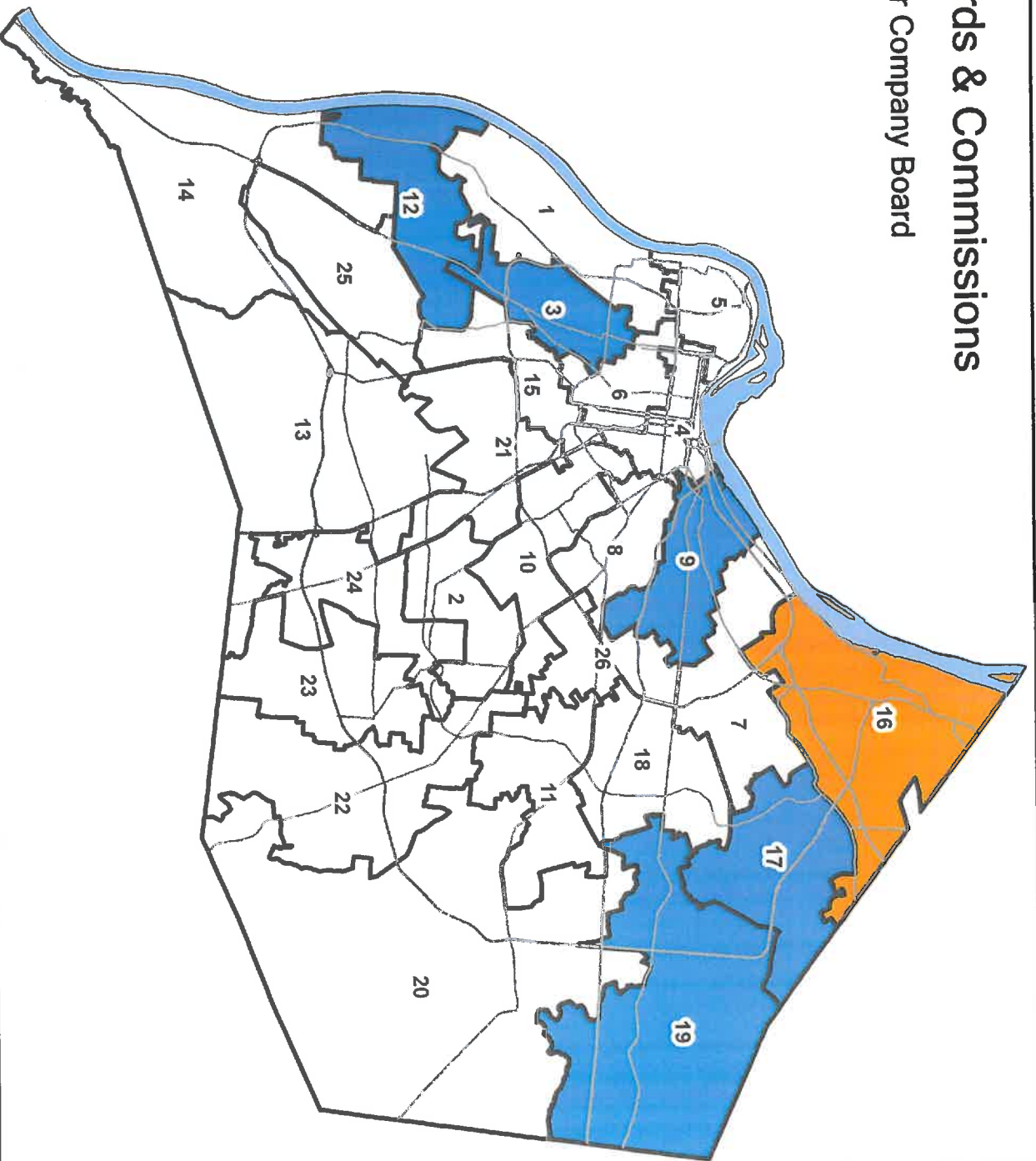
**BOARD REQUIREMENT
