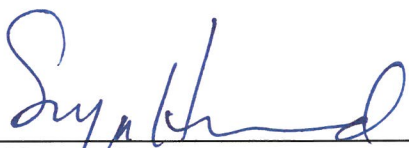

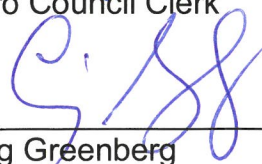
SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
