There needs to be four foot of sidewalk clearance left for pedestrians and wheelchairs once these garbage cans are in place.

- 1) TARC stop in front of 1350 So. 1st Street to replace the silver mesh one that is there. This garbage can should be fine in place of the existing can.
- 2) TARC stop at the intersection of Oak and Floyd. One was there but is now missing. This garbage can should be fine. Maintain existing clearance behind tree well.
- 3) Intersection of Magnolia and Brooke in front of 1380 So. Brook Street. Front of 1380 S Brook St the sidewalk looks a little too narrow. If you cross Magnolia to the SW corner along magnolia you should have enough room if you put the trash can along the curb but not too close to the handicap ramp.
