REQUEST

Amend Appendix Chapter 10 Appendix A and Appendix B of the Land Development Code related to preferred and prohibited tree lists

SUMMARY

A team of local Landscape Architects and tree experts from the public and private sectors has put together and reviewed a new tree list for both preferred and prohibited species. The list is proposed to replace the preferred and prohibited lists in Chapter 10 Appendix A and B. The current list contains 94 preferred species or cultivars, while the proposed list has 260. The current prohibited list contains 45 species or cultivars, while the proposed list has 13.

The list was developed to be broadly inclusive to encourage increased genetic diversity in Louisville's tree population. To make tree selection easier on those who prefer a shorter list, the most commonly planted tree species are listed in enlarged and bold typeface. Preferred vines and shrubs are not part of the proposed list. The current listings for those plant types are proposed to remain the same.

This request does not require a public hearing, since it is only proposing to change Appendices of the LDC. Staff recommends approval of the attached preferred and prohibited tree lists, with the exclusion of the statement "This list will be reviewed and updated periodically by the office of the Urban Forester" because it is the Planning Commission, for the purposes of the LDC, that will review and update the list.
