The Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources (KDFWR) entered into an agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) to operate an in-lieu fee mitigation program pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act and Kentucky Revised Statute 150.255 establishing the Kentucky Wetland and Stream Mitigation Fund.

This letter confirms the sale of 1,992 AMU Stream Credits in the amount of \$597,600.00. These credits are being used for compensatory mitigation of stream impacts in the Salt River Service Area authorized by USACE 404 Permit No. LRL-2012-737 and Kentucky Energy & Environment Cabinet Water Quality Certification No. 2014-015-7R.

KDFWR is assuming responsibility to provide mitigation for the permits listed above in selling these credits.
