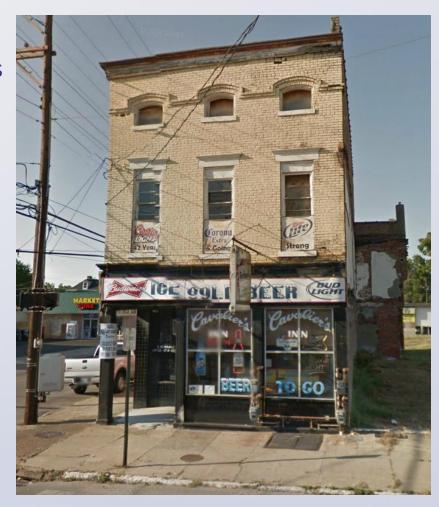

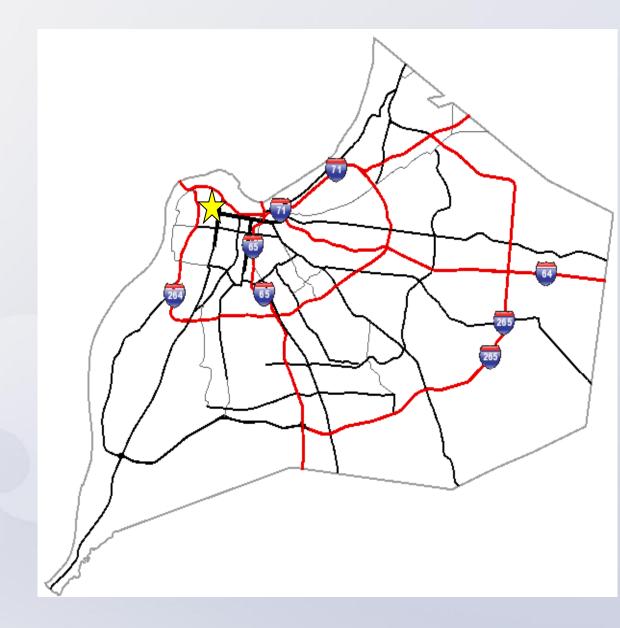
- The proposal has been revised from 2012 when the Cavalier Building was proposed for demolition.
- The Cavalier was subsequently approved for an Individual Local Landmark by the Landmarks Commission.
- The current proposal preserves the Cavalier Building with an attached addition.
- Two shotgun houses are also proposed for demolition which will require documentation as an historic resource.

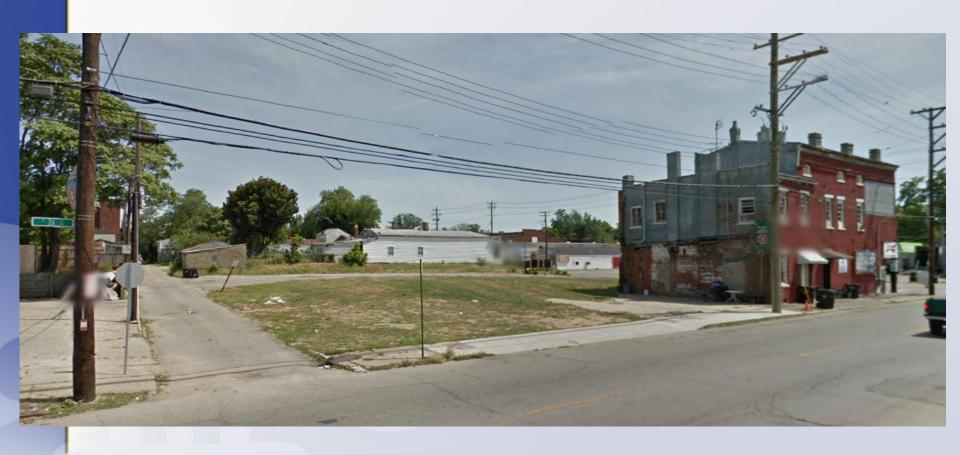






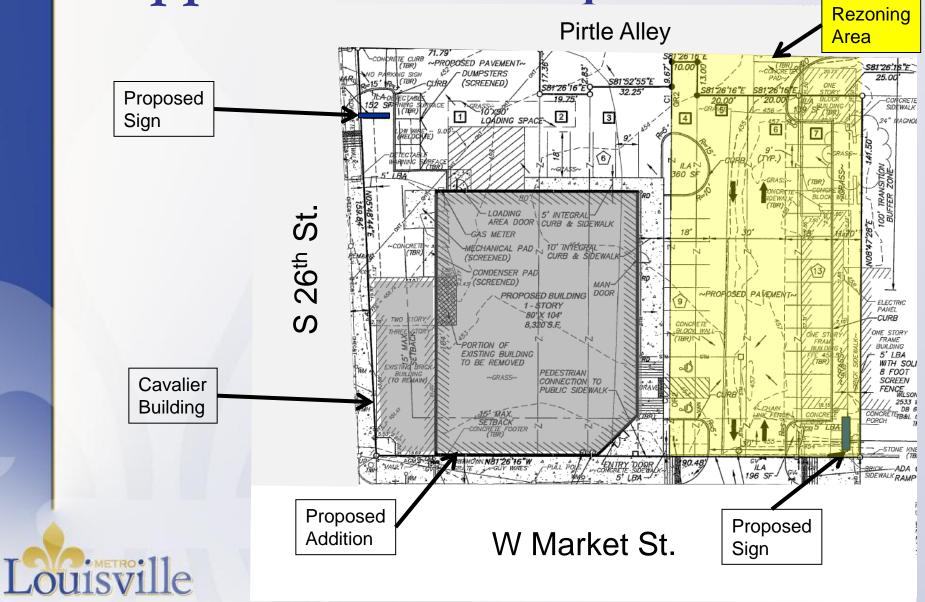




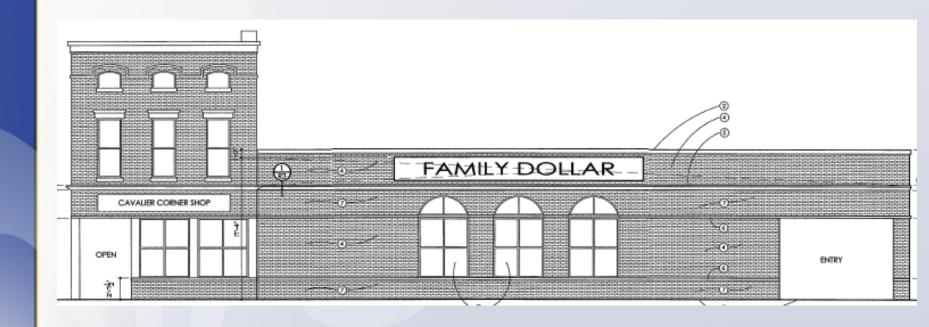




Applicant's Development Plan

PC Recommendation

- Public Hearing was held on 12/05/2013
- No one spoke in opposition at the Planning Commission public hearing. 1 person spoke at LD&T with concerns about the number of parking spaces and demolition of the 2 shotgun houses.
- The Commission made sufficient findings that the proposal complies with the Comprehensive Plan-Cornerstone 2020
- The Commission unanimously recommended approval of the rezoning to Louisville Metro Council (6 members voted)
