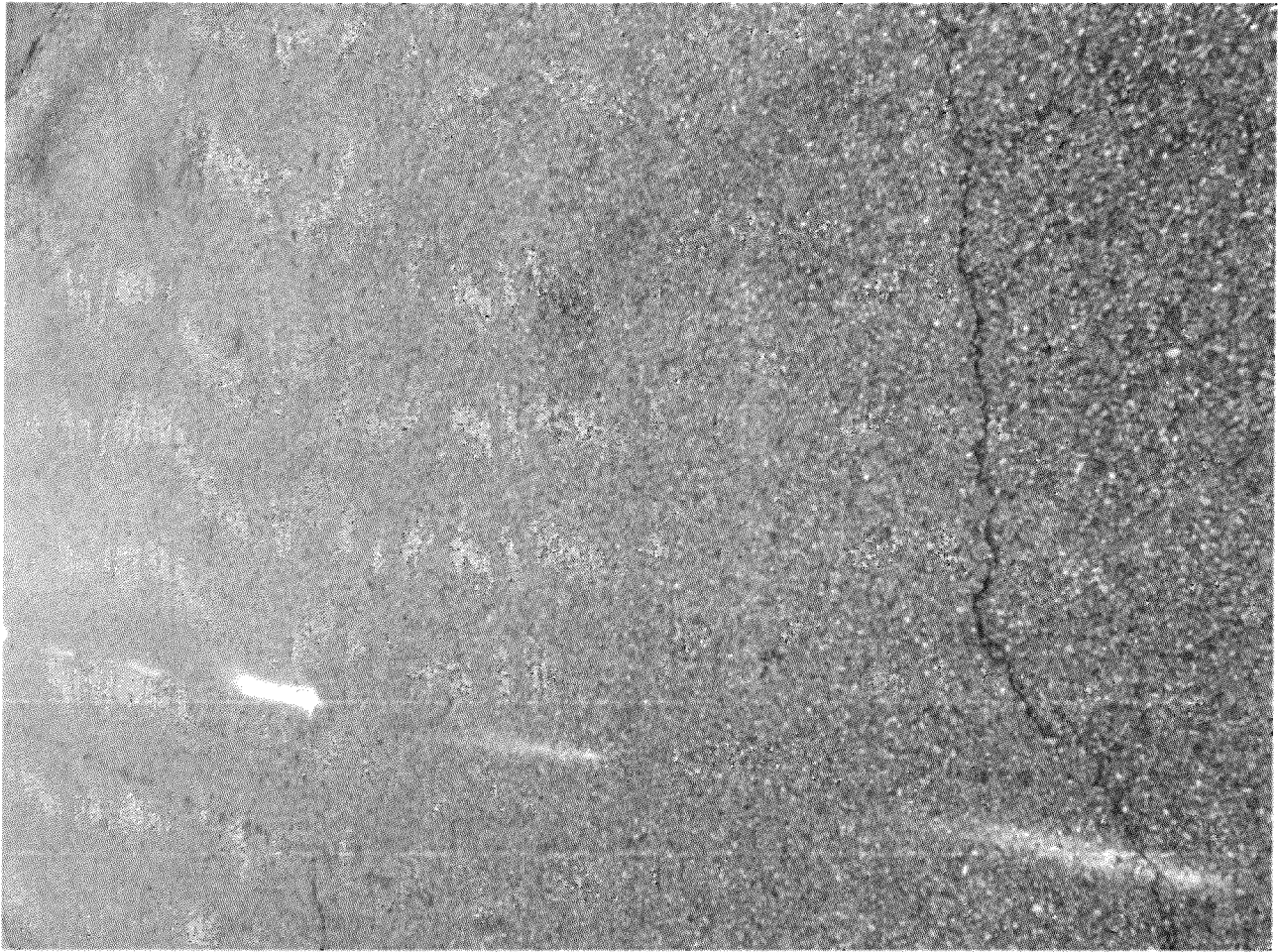
Can we work with PARC to get those parking t's repainted with thermal?
