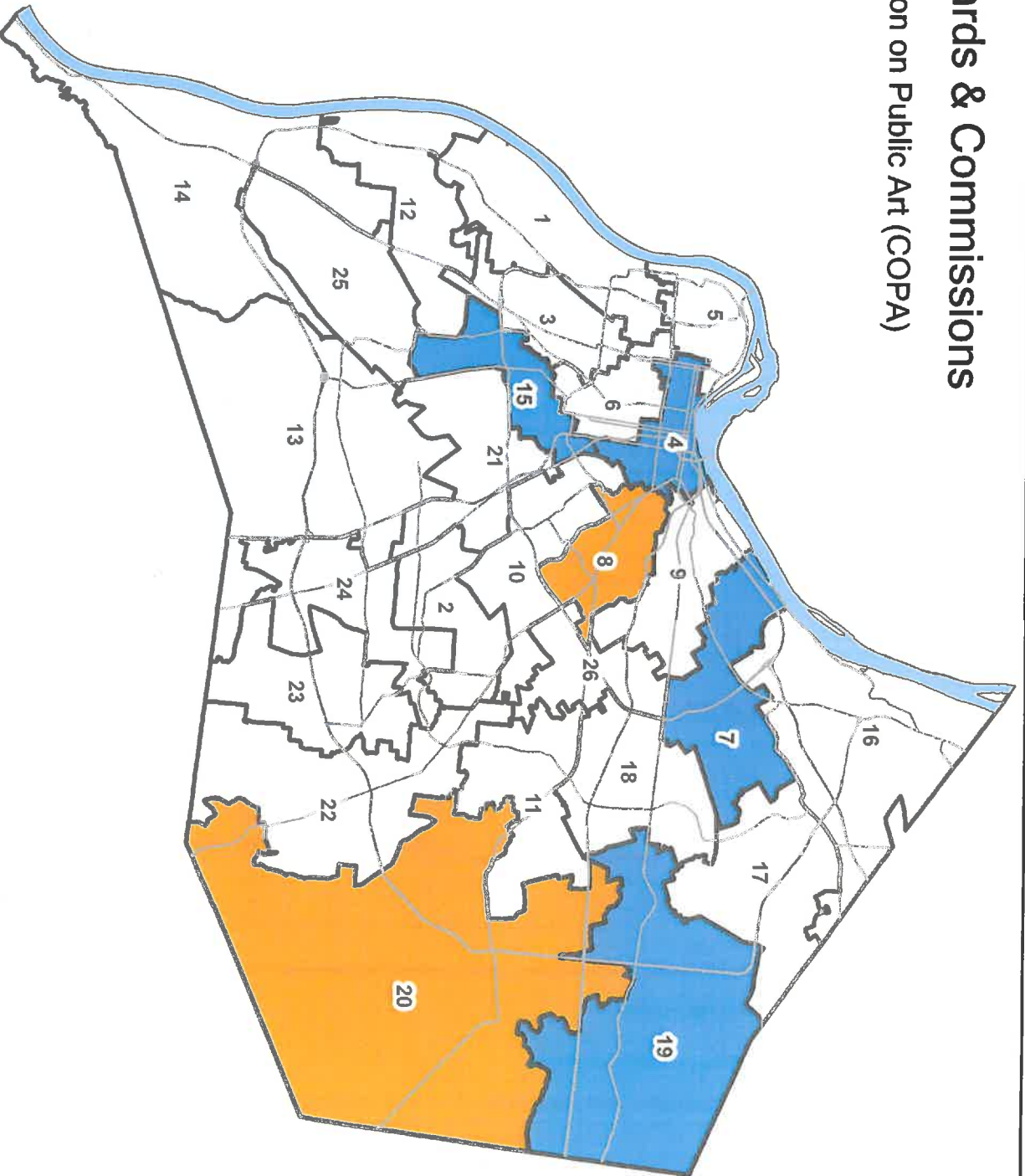

HOW APPOINTED	7 citizens appointed by the Mayor with Council approval
EX OFFICIO MEMBERS	Mayor, or designee Council member appointed by President of the Council Public Art Administrator (non-voting)
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	7 citizen members appointed by Mayor with Council approval: a) 2 shall be a civic/business leader in Louisville; b) 1 shall be faculty member of the art department of a university or college in Louisville; c) 4 shall be professionally involved in visual arts in Louisville. Up to 4 additional members must meet one of the requirements of a), b), or c) above. If an appointment is made under a) above, an appointment under c) above must also be made.

TERM OF APPOINTMENT	4 years or until their successor is appointed. Citizen members may be appointed for one succeeding term, except that members originally appointed to fill an unexpired term may be appointed for a second succeeding term. No member may serve for more than two full terms. Ex officio members appointment is coterminous with their office

	or position.
VACANCY APPOINTMENT	Mayor appoints a person to serve for the unexpired term.

POWERS	See Purpose. May apply for and accept grants and donations to the Louisville Public Space Art Fund. A restricted agency fund, the Louisville Public Space Art Fund, is funded by appropriations from Council and funds received from development projects as outlined in Section 5.12.2, item 3 of the Louisville Metro Land Development Code. It may also be funded through grants and donations from federal and state governments, corporations, foundations, individuals, and other not-for-profit organizations.
