All,

The cost of new sidewalk connection along the southside of Cleveland Blvd. would be **\$50,000**. The new sidewalk would have to be put on a new curb & gutter along here. Drainage should not be adversely impacted here since there is an exist. catch basin at the low point of the road already. There is a lot of Telecom equipment at the western edge of the project site. We may require a small Perm. Sidewalk Easement from the Adams Hill Town Houses property in order to get the new sidewalk around that equipment.
