I inspect it this morning and took some sidewalk repair measurements. There is a depression under the sidewalk that's caused the sidewalk failure. There's also a hole right up next to the curb. I'm going to ask Operations to come out and fill the hole next to the curb.

As for the sidewalk repair, it does meet the criteria for repair however since it was first reported in May 2020, it may be several years before it's next in line to be repaired with the sidewalk repair budget.

To whom it may concern,

I would like to reach out regarding the sidewalk and sinkhole in front of my house.

In May of 2020 I sent in a sidewalk or curb issue request via 311 – case #7985151 – 7507 Kendrick Crossing Ln., Louisville, KY 40291. It was quickly moved from submitted to received and then received to completed. I asked a number of times via the website what “completed” means with no response as obviously the sidewalk was never repaired. I then followed with a call and was informed that a crew has looked at the issue and said that it will need to be fixed. They are working on “funding” is what I was informed. I then followed up in July 2020 with an email to you and have not heard since.

I can tell you as far as funding goes – my taxes went up for my house 6% and I was required to pay that. I am asking that this sidewalk and sinkhole in front of my house be addressed as soon as possible.

I see numerous people in our neighborhood walking our sidewalks including seniors. I have noticed on multiple occasions folks tripping. My kids also walk this sidewalk to catch their ride to school every morning.

I would like for this to be addressed as soon as possible before there is a bigger issue and someone really gets hurt. I have attached several pictures to this email. The sinkhole is continuing to go underneath the street and I would hate for this piece to not be addressed as it is right next to the sidewalk.

Please advise as soon as possible on how/when this will be addressed.
