

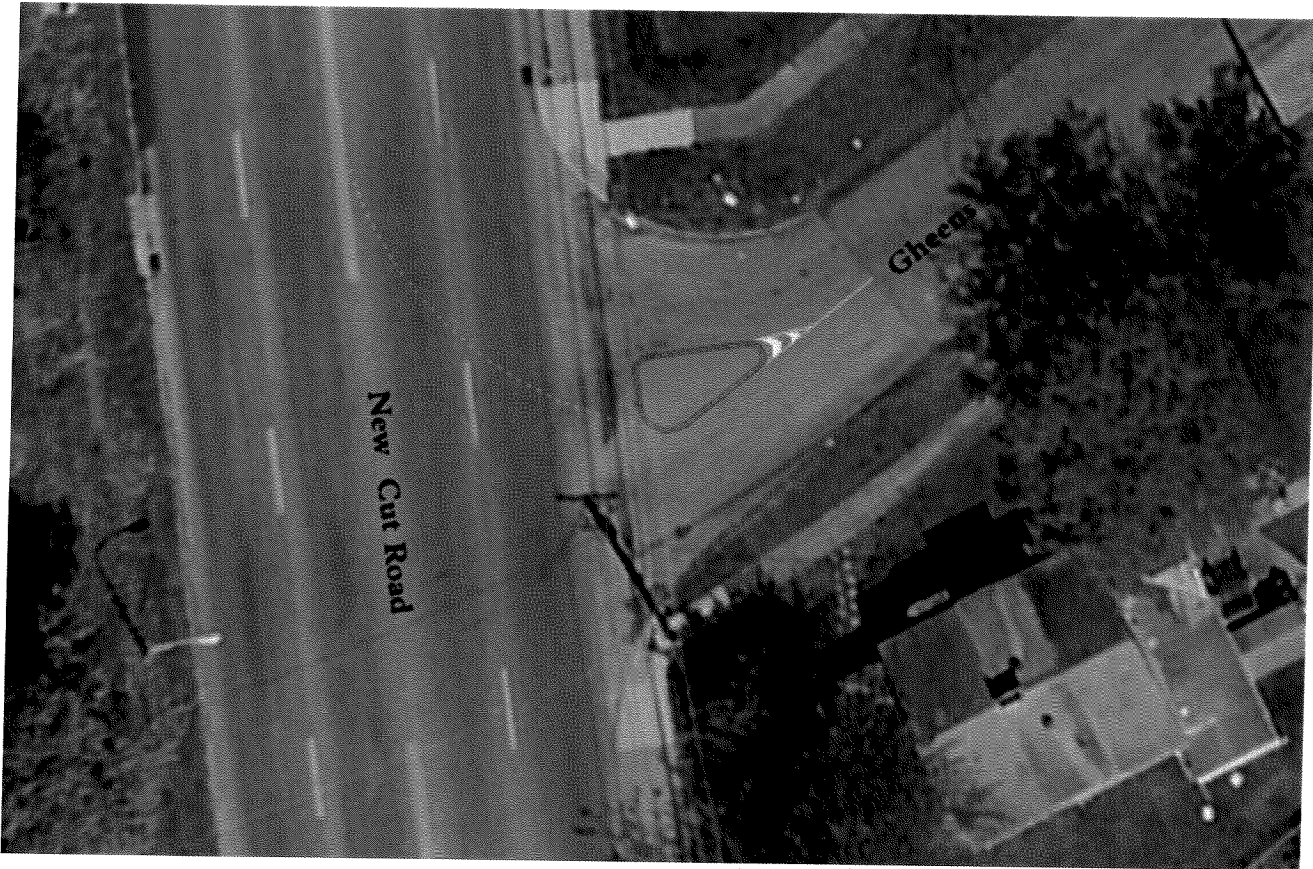
Thanks Steve! Once I receive the estimates on the cross walks and stop bars, I'll consider all at once.
