Hi Jeff!

This is the La Pinata restaurant at 4028 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Councilwoman George and I were speak of. She was contacted by the business, I believe and I was contacted by numerous residents. In my opinion, to address all concerns I would suggest parking "T's" like seen below (3 pics below the map) and the hatch marking at the intersections. (All 8 intersections – 2 at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, 2 at Southern Parkway and 4 at the alley. This alley is used heavily by residents to access their homes. In most cases it is their only access. That is why they stay upset at the businesses there, the restaurant and the Volley Ball courts)

Parking "T's" would identify where to park and the hatches hopefully will keep them out of the intersections. LMPD can use these to easier identify illegal parking. They have in other areas I have worked improved parking. There is no guarantee they will stay out of the hatch marked areas, however, over in St. Joe's it has worked wonders.

I can't make the meeting the 11<sup>th</sup> but wanted to explain my thoughts. At the very least can we see if this area is a candidate for all this and a cost estimate? In St. Joe's it was very reasonable. Thank you for your time and assistance in this matter!
