AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$6,650 FROM DISTRICT 20 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A TWO-YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT AND INSTALLATION OF ONE FLOCK CAMERA TO BE INSTALLED NEAR THE GRAND LAKES SUBDIVISION IN DISTRICT 20.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$6,650 is hereby appropriated from District 20 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department for a two-year lease agreement and installation of one Flock camera to be installed near the Grand Lakes subdivision in District 20.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
