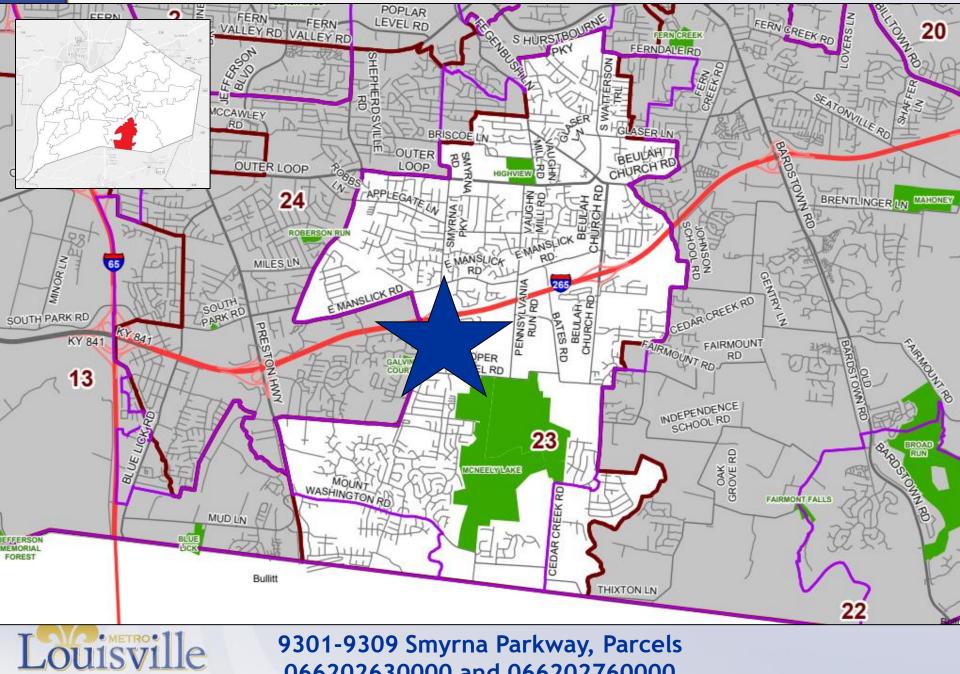

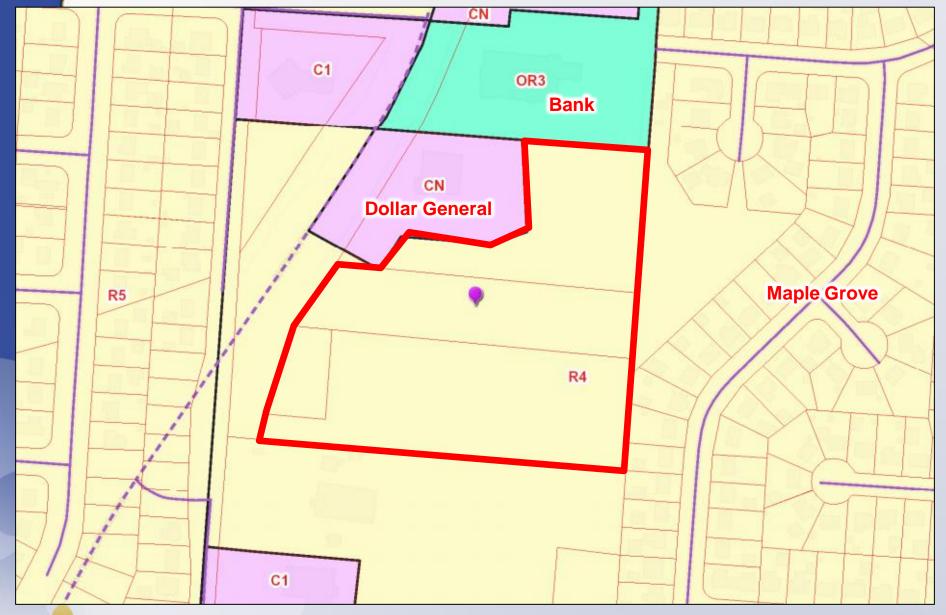

- Case was sent back to the Planning Commission so the applicant could correct tree preservation information
- Planning Commission reviewed the plan on October 7, 2021

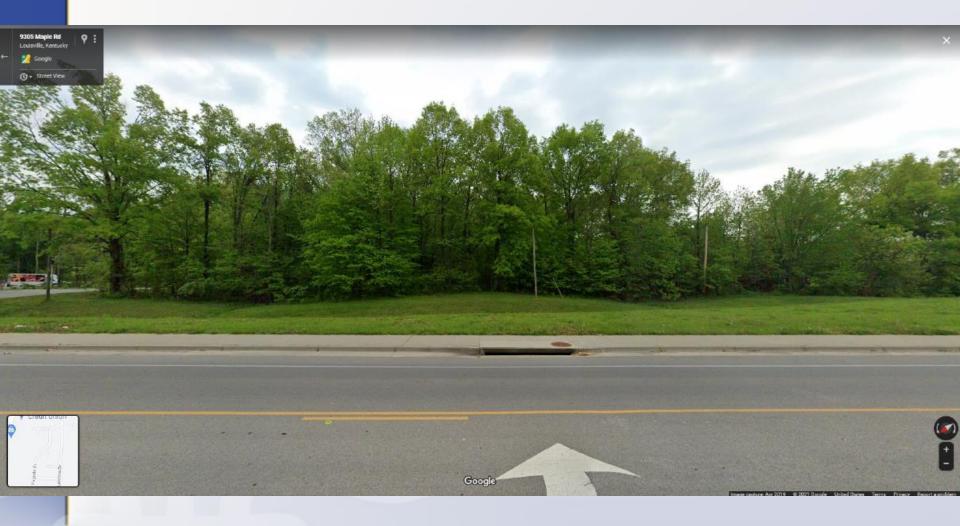


Case Summary

- 144 multi-family units on 8.8 acres
- Three story buildings
- Two detention basins provided on site adjacent to Smyrna Parkway
- Development is located in the Highview Neighborhood Plan (2015) study area
- New layout proposes to preserve 20 percent of the existing tree canopy

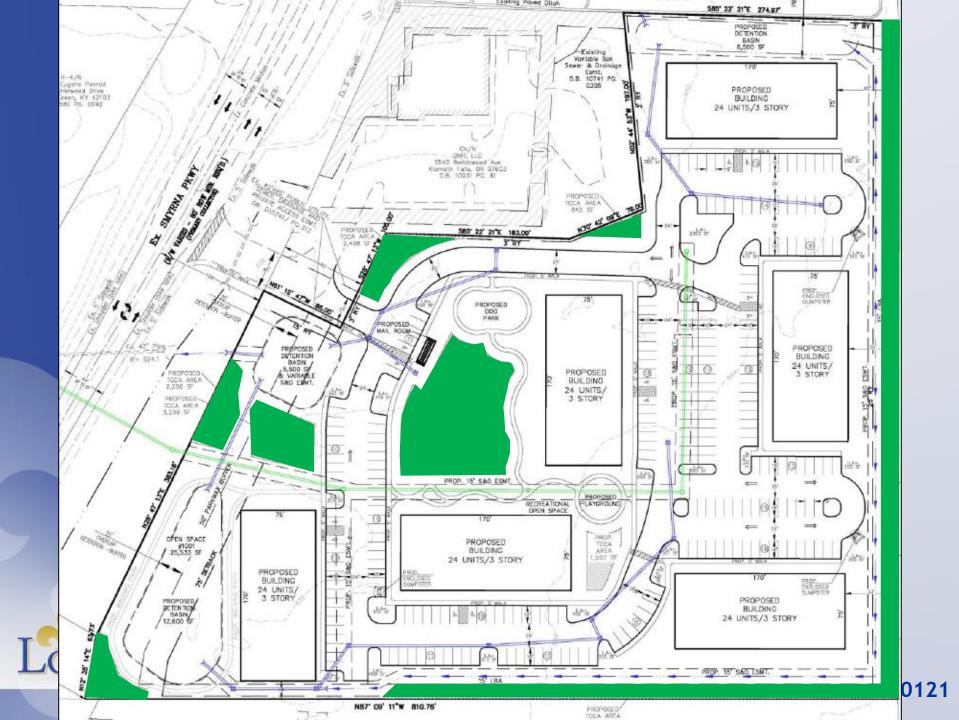

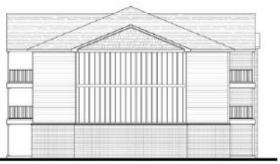


View into Site from Smyrna Parkway

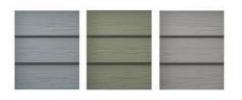




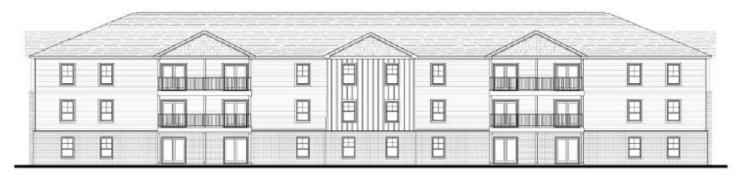
















Public Meetings
