I just got off the phone with CW George and she told me to email you a brief description of what we need for NNO. We need \$1,000 for the school supply kits, \$800 for the promotional items from MPC (LMPD whistles, bracelets, coloring books, etc.), \$400 for the hotdogs, \$350 for the band/DJ, and \$150 for a bounce house for the kids.
