Mayor Fischer,

The Greater Louisville Lodging Management District (The "District") is designed for the purpose of providing and financing economic improvements that specially benefit assessed properties within the District and hopes to have a direct impact on the development and ongoing success of Louisville as a tourism destination. All lodging properties of fifty (50) or more rooms located within the bounds of Jefferson County would be included in the District. We recognize this as a great opportunity to expand the marketing, promotions, and special events to the area and support the investment and growth already taking place.

48% of the total number of owners and 73.01% of the assessed value of lodging properties within the proposed boundaries of the District. Having received the required petitions from the property owners in excess of the amount required by KRS 91.754, I request that Metro Council enact an ordinance to approve the two proposed expansions of the Greater Louisville Lodging Management District.
