Hi Daniel,

I am following up on some items concerning Summit Hill prairie area in Iroquois Park. Since our last meeting concerning the off road vehicle activity along the mown trails in the prairie area, Olmsted Parks and Metro Parks have blocked off all non-sanctioned accesses onto the trail that meanders through the prairie. There were a total of 7 areas where the OPC crew placed very large logs supplied by the Metro Parks Forestry division. The Olmsted Parks crew also regraded some of the rutted areas. There is still some grading work to be completed. We will get to that ASAP.

We would like to add gates to a gravel road that accesses a picnic pavilion but has also provided access to the walking trails for off road vehicles. We need two gates for this road. I would like to use two tubular barrier gates for this function that can be locked when access to the picnic pavilion by car is not necessary. Please see attached for an example of one double gate. We would need two of these. The cost for two of these gates is approximately \$3,000. The Olmsted Parks crew can install them. Let me know if this is something the council woman would consider funding.
