Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Council President James called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. and asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Council President James spoke about the increase in COVID-19 cases, especially among children, and noted the number of people who have died (335) as of that morning and tested positive (18,928) as of the previous day in Louisville. He stated that we must not become complacent and we need to face this crisis as a community.

Council President James recognized that it was Domestic Violence Awareness Month and that the pandemic has also impacted this issue. He provided some statistics and stated that the clock tower at City Hall would be lit in purple in recognition of Domestic Violence Awareness. He provided the phone number for the Center for Women and Families, which is one of the resources for those impacted by this issue. The number is 1-844-BESAFE1 (1-844-237-2331).

He asked that everyone join him in a moment of silence.

Statement Regarding Virtual Attendance by Council Members

Council President James stated that the meeting was being conducted by video teleconference, pursuant to KRS 61.826 and in accordance with Senate Bill 150.
