Ben,

It does make a big difference. This would eliminate the need for updating ramps and only have to pave about half the area. The revised estimate would be \$15,000.00 for both Wickham Way and Millgate Rd.

In looking at google maps, I can see where the break between Metro and City of Lyndon responsibility is. It would make the most sense to me for Metro to partner with the City of Lyndon to pave the entire section from Farnham to the dead end. I think if this is done, the costs may also decrease slightly, but I am unsure what the City of Lyndon's timing would be to pave this. I say to partner with them because if we pave one half of the road, the residents on the other section will likely be upset with the City of Lyndon and vice-versa. We have done this kind of partnering with other small cities in the past.

Hi Matt,

I'm not sure if this would make a difference in cost but it would not need to be the entire portions of Millgate and Wickham north of Farnham. About two-thirds of those portions fall within Lyndon and are currently getting paved by the city of Lyndon. The only portions that would need to be paved would be along the last 10 (or so) homes on each road.

I posted a screenshot of the streets below. The highlighted portion is the area covered by Lyndon currently getting paved. Would this make the project cheaper? Thank you!

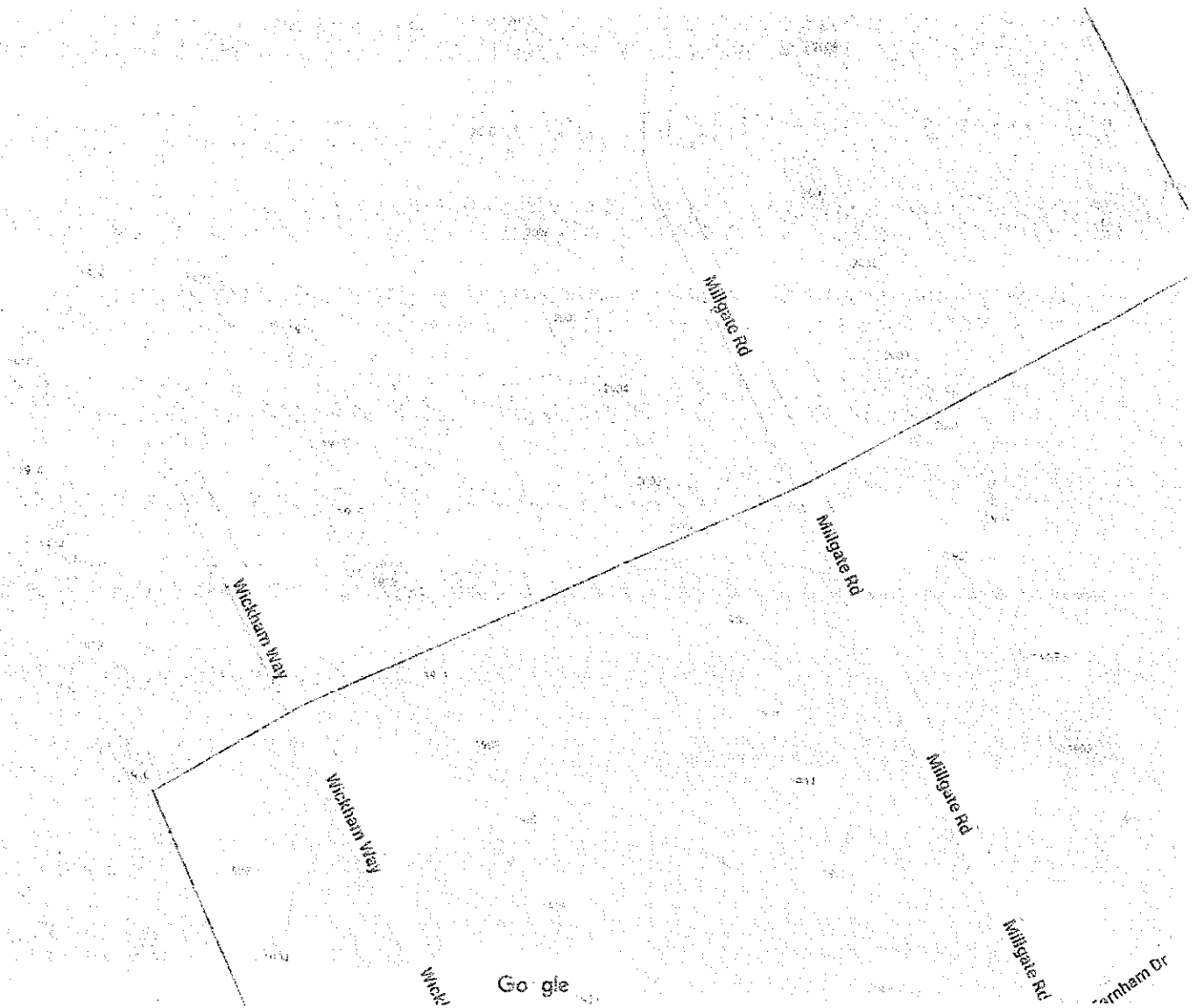
Hi Jeff,

Ben,

Just to recap our conversation, you were interested in having the Metro owner portions of Millgate and Wickham repaved from Farnham to the dead ends. Currently the ratings are 56, and 70 respectively but we are currently having our entire roadway network re-rated. Once those ratings are completed, a new 3 year plan will be put together based on the new PCI's. These roadways will likely be lower and may make it into the future 3 year plan. Alternately, District 7 can utilize CIF dollars to repave the roadways at which I estimate both sections to cost \$37,500.00. Ramps will be updated to meet ADA standards at both of these intersection in conjunction with the paving.
