

ORDINANCE NO. 003, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FROM DISTRICT 24 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT, 7<sup>TH</sup> DIVISION, TO FUND OVERTIME EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH CRIME REDUCTION, CRIME PREVENTION, AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The amount of \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from District 24 Neighborhood Development Funds to the Louisville Metro Police Department, 7<sup>th</sup> Division, to fund overtime expenses associated with crime reduction, crime prevention, and community outreach.


**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
