## Request

 Conditional Use Permit to allow short term rental of a dwelling unit not the primary residence of the host (LDC 4.2.63)



## Case Summary/Background

- As the dwelling unit is not the primary residence of the host, a CUP is required
- Located on the east side of Eastover Court south of Frankfort Avenue
- Adjoined by single-family and multi-family residential uses
- The residence contains four bedrooms. LDC regulations permit up to 12 guests; the applicant is limiting rental to 10 guests
- Both on-street and off-street parking is available
  - Two vehicles on street
  - One vehicle off the rear alley
- Neighborhood meetings held October 23 and November 8, 2018

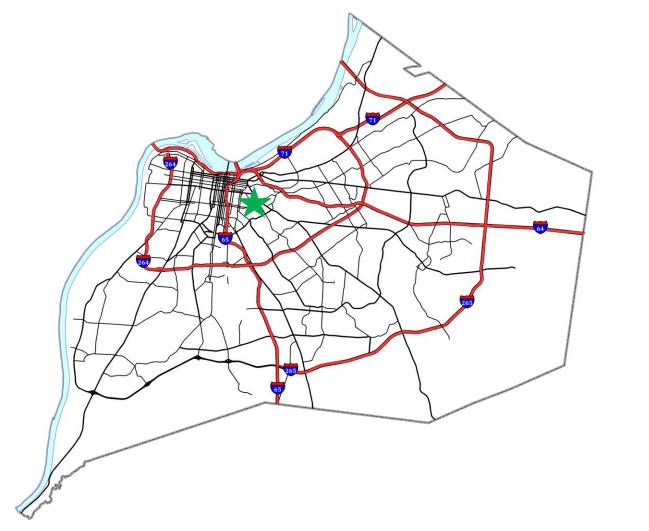

## Required Action

#### **Approve or Deny**

- Conditional Use Permit to allow short term rental of dwelling units not the primary residence of the host (LDC 4.2.63)
- Conditions of Approval
  - 1. Prior to commencement of any short term rental on the subject property, the host shall register the short term rental with Develop Louisville and with the Louisville Metro Revenue Commission. If the short term rental is not registered with Develop Louisville and with the Revenue Commission within 60 days of the approval of the minutes of this case, then the Conditional Use Permit shall be deemed null and void.
  - 2. The short term rental and host shall meet all additional provisions set forth in the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances.
