AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$5,500~~\$17,500 FROM DISTRICT ~~7~~ NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,500 FROM DISTRICT 7; \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 17, 18, 20, 22, AND 25; \$500 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 9, 13, 14, 16, 21, AND 26; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 10, 11, 12, AND 15; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE AMERICAN NATIONAL RED CROSS, LOUISVILLE AREA CHAPTER, FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE HOME FIRE CAMPAIGN AND "SOUND THE ALARM, SAVE A LIFE" PROGRAM. (AS AMENDED).


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The amount ~~sum~~ of ~~\$5,500~~\$17,500 is hereby appropriated from ~~District 7~~ Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,500 from District 7; \$1,000 each from Districts 17, 18, 20, 22, and 25; \$500 each from Districts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 9, 13, 14, 16, 21, and 26; and \$250 each from Districts 10, 11, 12, and 15; through the Office of Management and Budget, to The American National Red Cross, Louisville Area Chapter, for expenses associated with the Home Fire Campaign and "Sound the Alarm, Save a Life" Program.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
