BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The total of \$10,744 ~~\$21,419~~ is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds (NDF) in the following manner: ~~\$2,680~~ \$3,070 from districts 13, 12, 25, 14, 15; ~~\$3,069~~ from District 21; ~~\$2,677~~ \$1,500 each from districts 1, 3; 21, 12, 25; to the Louisville Metro Parks Department for expenses associated with the Jefferson Memorial Forest South Points Scenic Area Initiative.


SECTION II: The Council has determined that the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures, Section 3 as adopted by Resolution No. 290, Series 2011.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
