



CW Dorsey / Kalifa,

Please find below the estimates for two new sidewalk projects in District 3:

1. Along the south side of Millers Lane from Roger Hughes Way to Plantation Drive. The project estimate is **\$145,000**. This all includes costs for a topo and boundary survey, R/W services, new 5' wide concrete sidewalk, many concrete replacement aprons, detectable pavers, seeding and protection, 1 tree removal, and a contingency for anything unforeseen. The R/W portion of the project is \$50,000 of the proposed budget.
2. Along South 16th Street from Algonquin Parkway to the alley just south of that. The project estimate is **\$20,000**. This all includes costs for a new 5' wide concrete sidewalk, detectable pavers, seeding and protection, 1 tree removal, and a contingency for anything unforeseen.
3. For the restriping of Millers Lane, the project estimate is **\$6,500**. This would include two new white edge lines and a double yellow center line and stop bars and turn arrows.
