

They are in need of an additional \$16,300 to achieve their \$70,000 goal! They are hoping to complete the restoration of the memorial prior to their 2014 Memorial Day (Monday, May 26, 2014) ceremony.



Councilman Fleming,

The Patriots Peace Memorial restoration project would not be possible without the generosity of our community and I wanted to share with you the status of our project.

Since 2002, the Patriots Peace Memorial has honored the memories of armed forces personnel from our region, who have died, while serving on active, reserve or national guard duty, but not as a result of hostile enemy actions. Many of those enshrined have died in aircraft accidents, at sea, during physical training, and in transit, all in connection with military assignments. This memorial was conceived, constructed, and dedicated by local volunteers, who also maintain the structure.

Patriotic citizens have provided \$61,700 of our initial \$70,000 goal. I am respectfully asking for your help with the Metro Council to donate toward this project. We are a volunteer board, so 100% of your donation will be used for the restoration and maintenance of this monument.

Production of the 440 glass plates bearing the names and branch of service of our Patriots began in February, 2014. The process will take until mid April to complete.

Five (5) of the twelve (12) lights inside the memorial became inoperable this winter. Replacement of all these lamps with energy saving, long lasting state-of-the-art LED light fixtures has been accomplished. In addition, two (2) LED spot lights were installed at the base of the flagpole, with a separate time clock, so that the flag can be illuminated daily for a longer period of time than the memorial itself. The new lights ensure that this memorial remains a strong *Portal of Light* in honor of our fallen patriots.

Over the years, the memorial has become soiled by airborne algae spores and is in need of cleaning and sealing. This necessary cleaning, as well as the installation of new energy efficient lighting fixtures, were not anticipated and now bring the total cost of our restoration project to \$78,000.

Cleaning and sealing the Memorial began last week. Beginning this week through late May, weather dependent, we plan to remove the deteriorated glass plates, secure all interior metal, install the new glass plates, and remove and replace the grade level concrete sealant joints. Our goal is to complete the restoration in time for our annual Memorial Day ceremony.

Thank you in advance for providing a place in our community where members of our Armed Forces, who have lost their lives in non-combat military service, can be remembered and honored. We can't do it without you!

We hope to see you at our annual Memorial Day ceremony on Monday, May 26, 2014 at 12:00 noon. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or comments.

As you may have heard, the Patriot's Peace Memorial Board is a group of volunteers trying to provide our community a place where members of our Armed Forces, who have lost their lives in non-combat military service, can be remembered and honored. To ensure that the Patriot's Peace Memorial remains a meaningful tribute to those enshrined, they must restore this beautiful memorial.

The badly deteriorating 440 glass name plates bearing the names of the Patriots must be restored. Unfortunately the original design of the glass plates was unable to withstand the heat generated by direct sunlight and decomposition of the painted name on the plate occurred. The new design for the name plate corrects this issue. To date, they have raised \$56,369 toward the restoration of the Patriots Peace Memorial. They are in need of an additional \$13,631 to achieve their \$70,000 goal! They are hoping to complete the restoration of the memorial prior to their 2014 Memorial Day (Monday, May 26, 2014) ceremony.
