I am writing as a resident property owner of Ormond Road in St. Matthews, KY. My neighbors including those residing on Ormond Rd., Leland Rd., Washington Square, and Elmwood Ave. are adamantly and unanimously opposed to amending Binding Element #3 for the Masonic Home Property.

Along with other volunteers, we have carefully surveyed the residents of these four streets as well as nearby neighborhoods as reflected by the areas marked on the attached colored map. I plan on providing more details regarding the results of this survey at the public hearing on July 28, 2014. The surveys taken indicate that all of those responding on Ormond Rd., Leland Rd., Washington Square, and Elmwood Ave. are opposed to the application. The consensus of other neighbors surveyed revealed that they too are opposed to opening the four streets to carry additional traffic that only benefits Masonic Home residents and employees.

I am attaching 69 pages containing 932 signatures of individuals opposed to the application. I will make arrangements to hand deliver to your office a signed copy of this email and the originals of all petition pages.

It is my understanding and that of other neighbors that all documents were to be in by Friday so that they may be considered in the staff report and included as documents made available to the Planning Commissioner members prior to the hearing.


