Parents must show one of the following documentations to qualify for the reduced fees.

- Current AFDC Award Letter must have household income
- Income tax from previous year
- Current Food Stamp Award must have household size and income
- Current Social Security Award Letter or SSI letter with child's name listed
- Current Housing Certification Letter with child's name listed as resident

In the past years Southwick Community Center would only accept sixty youth, but with crime rising in our city we have a goal of eighty youth this summer. Mr. Moore's motto was FEED THE CHILDREN.
