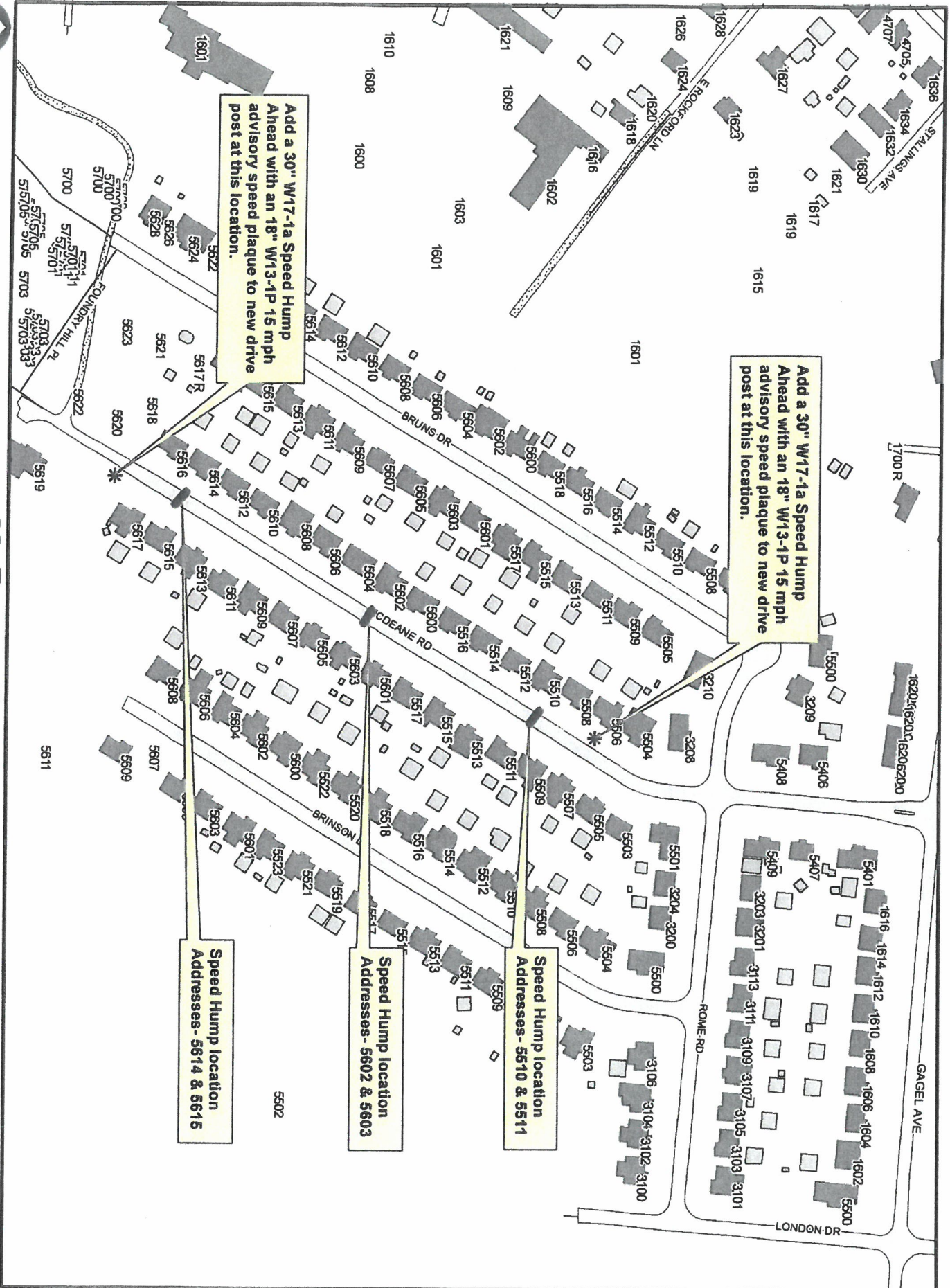
Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as weather permits.



Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as weather permits.

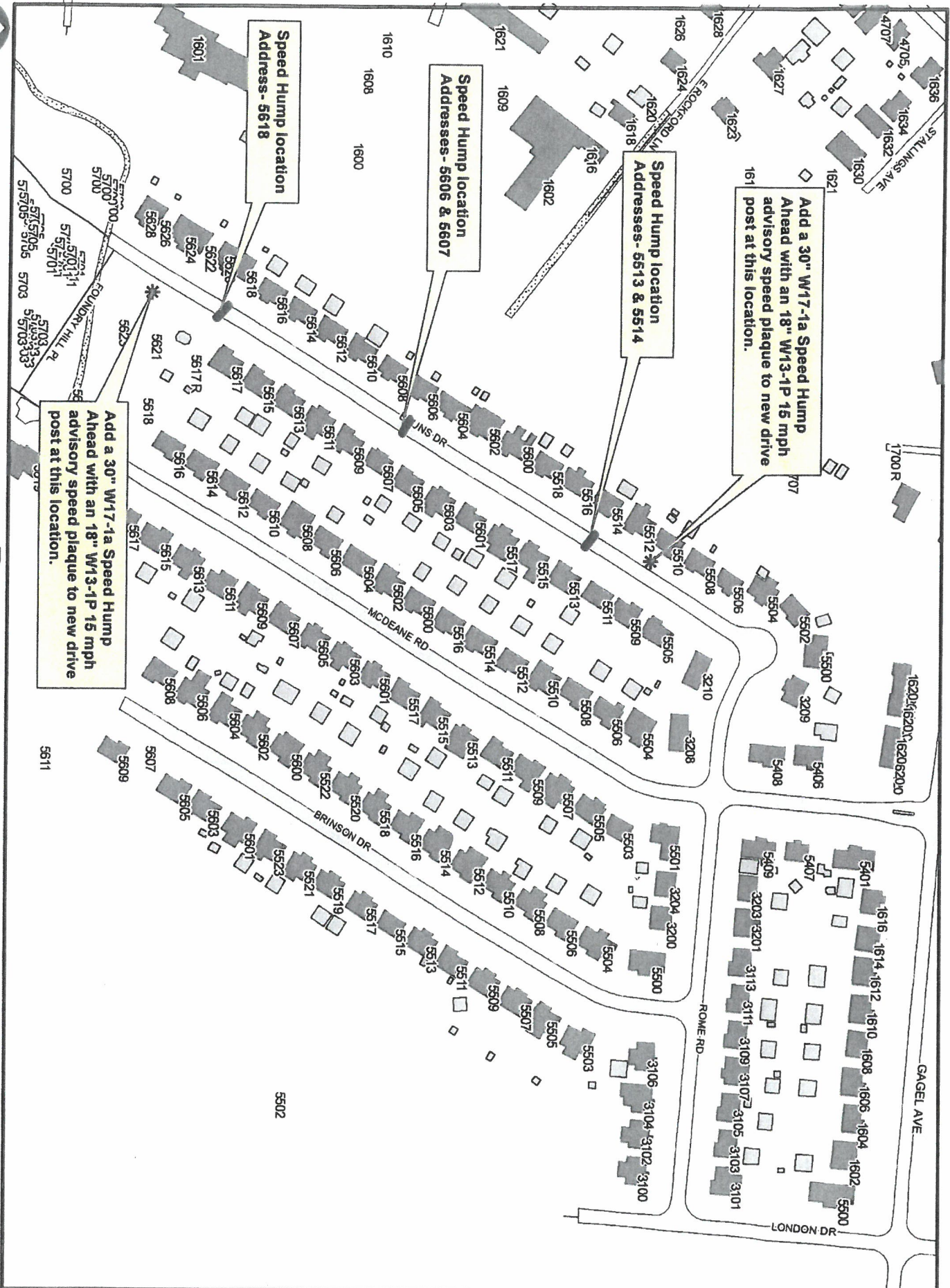
