

ORDINANCE NO. 046, SERIES 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 115, SERIES 2017 AND ORDINANCE NO.114, SERIES 2017 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS, RESPECTIVELY, BY TRANSFERRING \$40,000 FROM THE CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND (DISTRICT 5) TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUND (DISTRICT 5) AND BY TRANSFERRING \$13,000 FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUND (DISTRICT 5) TO DEVELOP LOUISVILLE SUPPORTING METRO HOUSING RESOURCE CENTER CONTRACTUAL EXPENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:


f. Included in G. 2. a. (1) above is ~~\$90,000~~ \$103,000 to continue the contract with Metro Housing Resource Center for District 1 (\$20,000), District 3 (\$50,000) and District 5 (~~\$20,000~~) (\$33,000) emergency home repair programs, exterior paint and dusk to dawn lights to be disbursed in one lump sum.

SECTION V: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.


SECTION VI: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.


