Scott,

In reviewing Brookhollow Dr we have noticed that there are cul-de-sacs which maintain the Brookhollow Dr name for address. We plan to pave these as part of the remainder of the road paving. I wanted to recommend that Beechlawn Ct, Beechdale Ct, and Briarhollow Ct be added to this paving. I believe we can pave these 3 courts and stay within the \$157,000.00 budget or close to it. This will only leave Brookhollow Ct as the lone cul-de-sac not paved with this project which is substantially longer than any of the other courts I have mentioned. I wanted to get your concurrence on doing this prior as Brookhollow Dr is scheduled to be paid for with CIF bond and match dollars. If we go over budget, Public works will cover the remainder.

Please let me know you agree and if anything needs to happen prior to starting this work.
