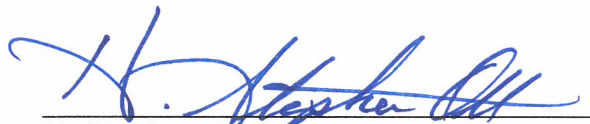

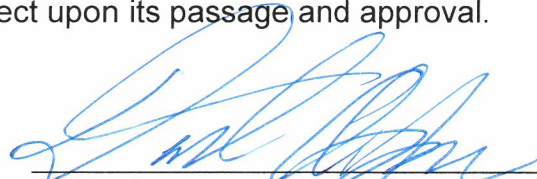
WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to enter into this agreement through Develop Louisville.

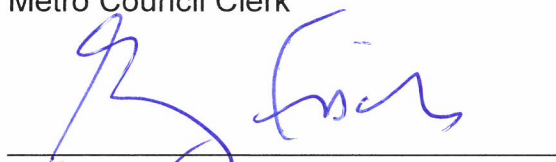
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the US Department of Interior to accept \$50,000 of National Park Service funds to conduct an in-depth research and field survey of Louisville's historic Chickasaw Neighborhood for consideration to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
