Liz,

Here are the estimates you requested:

1. Ledgewood Parkway – this is the entrance to the Ledgewood Apartments. It's a private road and is being maintained by the apartment complex. I'm not sure how it made it into our inventory but I've made the correction.
2. Pikes Peak Blvd from Manslick Road to Table Mountain Avenue: \$80,000
3. Greenview Drive from Lower Hunters Trace to Hunters Point Circle: \$70,000
4. Milner Road – this road isn't in terrible shape, I would hold off on any paving here for another year or two.
5. Mount Holyoke Drive from Hunters Point Circle to Mount Blanc Road: \$60,000
6. Barbrook Road from 7614 Norwich Blvd to Kenhurst Drive: \$12,000
7. Johnsonstown Road from Tradeport to Yuma Way (D14): \$32,000
8. Johnsonstown Road from Yuma Way to Johnsonstown Drive (D12): \$28,000
9. Johnsonstown Road from Johnsonstown Drive to Greenbelt (D14): \$100,000

- Hunters Point – Mount Everest – 28
- Mount Everest – Matterhorn – 47
- Matterhorn – Mount Marcy – 55

Barbrook (Norwich to Kenhurst) – Rated 27
